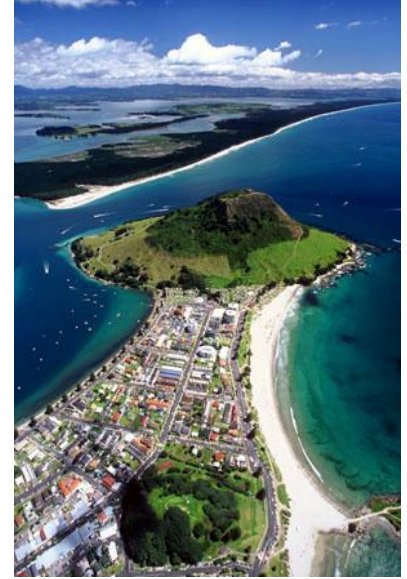


# 2008 GIS In Schools Institute

**The Bureta Park Motor Inn which is the closest accommodation to the College.**

There are 19 rooms and all are available. 17 of the rooms have a Queen and one single, 1 room has just a Queen and 1 room has 2 x singles in it. The rate is \$100 per night over the weekend (single or twin it is a room rate) and \$90 on a Mon night or \$80 if you are a single. The rooms have tea and coffee making facilities and a continental breakfast is served in the rooms each morning. (Cereal, fruit, toast, tea, coffee). The Motor inn also has a bar and a buffet restaurant where you can eat a buffet roast meal and as much as you want for \$15.50 a head for dinner.



Backpackers: Just the Duck's Nuts. Rates there are \$21/night for place in 6 bedroom dorm, \$23/night for 3-4 bedroom dorm and \$25 per person in a double room. You would have to make your own booking here.
